### **BUILD A BILLY CART PROGRAM FOR KIDS ON THE SPECTRUM!**

#### **WHAT IS THE BUILD A BILLY CART PROGRAM?**

The build a billy cart program is part of our “grass roots” evidence-based programs being run across 2021. The aim is to get kids off technology for a while and learn some hands-on skills while having fun in a supported socially safe environment and build something that they can be proud of.

#### **WHAT SKILLS WILL MY CHILD LEARN FROM THIS PROGRAM?**

These programs objectives are to aid children on the spectrum across multiple areas commonly associated with autism spectrum differences. Your child will practice their social skills, learn the importance of persistence, sharing, hand eye coordination, emotional regulation, confidence, self-worth, making and maintaining healthy relationships, teamwork, preplanning skills, independence, skill acquisition and capacity building.

#### **HOW WILL I KNOW IF MY CHILD HAS DEVELOPED ANY OF THESE SKILLS?**

All our participants are data tracked throughout the program to document their progress in detail. Your child’s allocated staff member will be the one that completes this process throughout each class. At the end of the program, your child’s data is analysed and incorporated with your NDIS progress report for evidence and possible identification of your child’s strengths and difficulties.

#### **WHAT IS INCLUDED IN THE PROGRAM PRICE? AND WHO CAN APPLY?**

The price of the program includes your child’s billy cart building kit, paint, all tools for usage throughout the program, a ratio of 1:1 support from blue carded highly skilled and qualified staff members of KC4U, a graduation certificate and a progress report for NDIS.

All plan and self-managed NDIS participants are eligible, including self-funded participants.

**YES, YOUR CHILD KEEPS THEIR BILLY CART FOR GOOD!**

#### **WHAT DO I NEED TO SUPPLY MY CHILD WITH FOR THE PROGRAM?**

A hat, sunscreen, and a water bottle!

#### **HOW, WHEN AND WHERE DOES THE PROGRAM OPERATE?**

The program is run on Saturday mornings for a period of one hour per class over a period of 6 consecutive weeks. The first four classes are held at our premises 78 Hampton Street Harristown QLD 4350. The last two weeks of the program are held at Picnic Point Park Toowoomba. Your child will be required to be dropped off and picked up by you for each class. You will also be responsible for arranging the transport of your child’s completed billy cart to take home on the final week of the program.

Your child's time on the Saturday will be advised once classes have been finalised.

### **WHAT DOES THE PROGRAM LOOK LIKE OVER THE 6 WEEKS BRIEFLY?**

**Commences on the 16<sup>th</sup> of January 2020.**

**Week 1:** Introduction's to staff members and fellow classmates, a briefing on behaviour expectations and what to expect throughout the program. Staff allocations to participants. Commencement of building begins.

**Week 2:** Continue building

**Week 3:** complete building and pre plan designs for your cart.

**Week 4:** painting and decorating our carts

**Week 5:** Picnic point park grass hills learning how to safely operate and ride our carts

**Week 6:** graduation party, certificate ceremony, photos and take your carts home!

### **WHEN AND HOW DO I PAY FOR THE PROGRAM?**

An invoice will be sent out to you on the day after completion of the program. Payment is required within 7 days of receiving the invoice.
